



COACH'S CODE OF ETHICS

1. Show respect for players, officials and other coaches.
2. Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials and adhere to a "no tolerance" approach to arguing with officials
3. Establish and model fair play, sportsmanship, and proper conduct.
4. Establish player safety and welfare as the highest priority.
5. Provide proper supervision of students at all times.
6. Refrain from the use of profanity, vulgarity, and other offensive language and gestures.
7. Use discretion when providing constructive criticism and when reprimanding players.
8. Maintain consistency in requiring all players to adhere to the established rules and standards of the game to be played.
9. Properly instruct players in the safe use of equipment.
10. Avoid recruitment of athletes from other programs.
11. Follow the rules of behavior and the procedures for crowd control as established by the SCYSA and the GCYFL.
12. Actively promote good player behavior at home, school and within the community (build good kids)
13. Require parents/fans to exhibit good sportsmanship (no arguing with refs, taunting or criticizing other clubs)
